Administrative History

The United Nations Observer Group in Central America (ONUCA) was established through United Nations Security Council Resolution 644 adopted on 7 November 1989, in order to observe and report on compliance to the Esquipulas II Agreement by the Governments of Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua. ONUCA operated from November 1989 until 17 January 1992.

ONUCA was created following a request by the governments of Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua for assistance in implementing the Esquipulas II Agreement, also known as "A Procedure for the Establishment of a Firm and Lasting Peace in Central America" or the Guatemala Procedure. Under its original mandate, ONUCA was charged with conducting verification of compliance, specifically the "cessation of aid to irregular forces and insurrectionist movements; the non-use of the territory of one State for attacks on other States, and preventing the establishment or use of facilities for radio or television transmissions for the specific purpose of directing or assisting the military operations of irregular forces or insurrectionist movements in any of the five countries." When a complaint against one Government was registered with ONUCA, its practice was to communicate the complaint to that Government and ask that their full cooperation be extended to ONUCA in an investigation. The results of the investigation were then transmitted to both Governments concerned.

In December 1989, an advance team established ONUCA's headquarters in Tegucigalpa, Honduras. By June 1990, ONUCA was operating at full strength, with liaison offices in each of the five capitals as well as verification centres in smaller cities. Key roads and border crossings were monitored by mobile Operational Patrol Posts (OPPs) of up to seven United Nations Military Observers (UNMOs), and daily patrols were conducted by UNMOs by land, air, and sea.

On 12 December 1989, the five Central American Presidents issued the Declaration of San Isidro de Coronado in which they requested ONUCA's mandate be expanded to include verification of the cessation of hostilities and voluntary demobilization of the Nicaraguan Resistance. Following the elections in Nicaragua, an agreement was reached on 15 March 1990 between the Nicaraguan Government, the Government-elect, and the United Nations, and ONUCA's mandate was formally expanded through Security Council Resolution 650 adopted on 27 March 1990. This expanded mandate increased ONUCA's size and added an armed battalion from Venezuela (VENBATT) to the mission.

After intensive negotiations, the Nicaraguan Government and representatives from the Nicaraguan Resistance signed a series of agreements, including a ceasefire beginning on 19 April 1990 and established eight security zones, in which members of the Nicaraguan Resistance were demobilized by unarmed UNMOs and armed VENBATT troops. The Nicaraguan Government forces withdrew from the security zones allowing members of the Nicaraguan Resistance to assemble there. The parties requested ONUCA's support in monitoring the ceasefire and separation of forces, and the mission's mandate was expanded three times over the course of the demobilization through Security Council Resolutions 653 (1990), 654 (1990) and 656 (1990).

ONUCA's participation in the demobilization of the Nicaraguan Resistance within Nicaragua and Honduras, known as Operation Home Run, included the establishment of temporary assembly points; the handover of weapons,

military equipment, and military uniforms; and collaboration with the International Support and Verification Commission (CIAV) in repatriating and resettling the demobilized forces. Although logistical difficulties and distrust between the Nicaraguan Government and the Nicaraguan Resistance slowed the process down, the demobilization process was successfully completed on 5 July 1990 with the demobilization of 22,773 armed and unarmed members of the Nicaraguan Resistance and a total of 17,883 weapons handed over to ONUCA.

Upon the completion of the demobilization of the Nicaraguan Resistance, ONUCA reverted to fulfilling its original mandate to verify compliance with the Esquipulas II agreements and to patrol areas where violations were most likely to occur in the five countries. The mandate was extended three more times through Security Council Resolutions 675, 691, and 719, with corresponding reductions in the mission's size. Over the course of the mission, ONUCA was led by three Chiefs of Mission (CMO): Agustín Quesada Gámez (November 1989 – December 1990); Lewis MacKenzie (December 1990 – May 1991); and Víctor Suanzes Pardo (May 1991 – January 1992).

On 28 October 1991, the Secretary-General reported to the Security Council that the situation in the area had greatly improved, and the five countries were making efforts to adhere to the commitments agreed to in the Esquipulas II agreements. ONUCA's mandate was terminated by Security Council Resolution 730, dated 17 January 1992. As part of Operation Paloma Blanca, 131 ONUCA military observers were transferred to the United Nations Observer Mission in El Salvador (ONUSAL) on 24 January 1992, while other ONUCA staff members supervised the closing of the mission and were retained and phased out over a period of three and a half months.

Scope and Content

The functional description of records in AG-076 is based on the retention schedule of the United Nations Peacekeeping Records Retention Schedule (Field Missions), dated November 2015. The names of the series comprising AG-076 were drawn from the function series listed in the retention schedule.

Scope and Content

The records in S-1960 contain correspondence, memoranda, code cables, faxes and reports of the military component of the United Nations Observer Group in Central America (ONUCA), established through Security Council Resolution 644 (1989) of 7 November 1989. The function of S-1960 is derived from PKO-MIL-101 of the United Nations Peacekeeping Records Retention Schedule (Field Missions), dated November 2015. The bulk of the records are from 1989 to 1992.

As established in its original mandate, the military component of ONUCA was responsible for the verification of compliance with the Esquipulas II Agreement, specifically: "the cessation of aid to irregular forces and insurrectionist movements and the non-use of the territory of one State for attacks on other States," by the governments of Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras and Nicaragua. Led by the Chief Military Observer (CMO) and supported by the Deputy Chief Military Observer (DCMO), the military component at ONUCA headquarters was comprised of the Chief Operations Officer (COO), Military Information Officer (MIO), Chief Military Personnel Officer (CMPO) and Senior Medical Officer (SMO). Five liaison offices were established in the capitals of Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras and Nicaragua, and each was led by a Chief of the Observer Group (COG) who reported directly to the CMO.

S-1960 contains subject files of the DCMO, which are arranged alphabetically and include: correspondence and memoranda, code cables, cryptofaxes and reports. The DCMO also held the position of ONUCA Chief of Staff (COS) and was responsible for all operational and administrative matters relating to ONUCA's military component. In addition to coordinating day-to-day activities for United Nations Military Observers (UNMOs), the DCMO was also responsible for planning and proposing changes to ONUCA's organizational structure. Brigadier General Ian C. Douglas held the position of DCMO from 1989 through August 1990. He was succeeded by Lieutenant Colonel Byman and Colonel Ian McNabb, respectively.

The records of the DCMO include: administrative directives and information circulars; monthly reports of the CMO; information summaries of the MIO; reports and recommendations for changes to ONUCA's organizational structure; and security evacuation plans for Observer Groups in El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras and Nicaragua. Other records include correspondence and memoranda documenting administrative and operational matters; the establishment of the United Nations Observer Mission in El Salvador (ONUSAL); and planning for visits of foreign political and military leaders.

A large portion of the records detail Operation Home Run. Following the expansion of its mandate through Security Council Resolutions 650 and 653, ONUCA's responsibilities grew to include the voluntary demobilization of the Nicaraguan Resistance and the monitoring of the separation of forces. These records include: operation directives and post-operation reports from COGs relaying concerns and recommendations, as well as correspondence and memoranda detailing the progress of the demobilization, liaison with the International Support and Verification Commission (CIAV), and meetings with the Nicaraguan government and representatives of the Northern, Central and Atlantic Fronts (Yatama) of the Nicaraguan Resistance.

S-1960 also contains the subject files of the COO, who was responsible for air, naval and land operations as well as contingency planning and training of UNMOs. The COO also oversaw: preparation of operational orders, directives and related correspondence; coordination of the deployment of UNMOs; briefings for conferences and visits; development of security and evacuation plans; supervision of the ONUCA Operation Centre; and coordination with ONUCA Observer Groups regarding operational matters.

The records of the COO are arranged alphabetically and contain: Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs); operation orders and directives; briefing materials on ONUCA for recently deployed UNMOs; drafts and final versions of security evacuation plans for ONUCA headquarters as well as for the Observer Groups in Costa Rica, El Salvador and Honduras; and reports of staff visits to the Observer Group Liaison Offices, Verification Centres and Operational Patrol Posts (OPPs).

Operation orders and directives cover various ONUCA operations, including: Operation Home Run and the demobilization of the Nicaraguan Resistance; Operation Palomino, in which ONUCA facilitated the transport of seven FMLN commanders to and from Mexico City as part of ongoing peace talks with the government of El Salvador; and Operation Paloma Blanca, which allowed for the transfer of UNMOs from ONUCA and establishment of the Military Division following the ceasefire agreement between the Frente Farabundo Martí para la Liberación Nacional (FMLN) and the Salvadorian government.

A small amount of these records document Lt. Colonel Antonio Burgos's role as the Chief Brazilian Officer, a role he held concurrently as COO. These records include correspondence and memoranda related to the deployment of the Brazilian contingent; monthly personnel summaries; and several Brazilian publications in Portuguese that were intended for military personnel.

S-1960 also includes the records of the MIO, who was responsible for collecting, evaluating and disseminating information pertinent to the mandate on topics such as: armed forces; local governments; political affairs; social and economic affairs; religious affairs; and insurgent and subversive forces. These records contain information summaries, press clippings, briefing materials, incident reports, correspondence, and meeting minutes. The information summaries compiled relevant political and military events in each country from news sources and reports from Observer Group Liaison Offices and were distributed to the CMO and ONUCA senior officers. Lieutenant-Colonel F. Javier Zorzo served as the first MIO from 1989 to December 1990. He was succeeded by Rafael Salas Arjona, December 1990-November 1991, and J. Camarero, November 1991-January 1992.

The MIO records also contain documents from the Observer Group Liaison Offices, including situation and patrol reports, country briefings, press summaries, and correspondence sent from the Observer Groups. The records also include correspondence, reports, and press clippings regarding resistance groups in Nicaragua, El Salvador and

Honduras and the demobilization of the Nicaraguan Resistance, as well as a photo album containing 43 colour photographs of UN vehicles and UNMOs in uniform.

All three MIOs served as Senior Spanish Officers and retained records concerning administrative matters of the Spanish UNMO contingent related to deployment, assignments, arrivals and repatriation.

Other records in S-1960 document the Observer Group Liaison Offices in Costa Rica, Honduras and Nicaragua. Each Observer Group had several verification centres and OPPs, as well as a chief stationed at the Liaison Office. The records are arranged alphabetically and contain daily press summaries; SOPs; operations directives; incoming and outgoing correspondence and memoranda. The incoming and outgoing correspondence and memoranda detail administrative, personnel and operational matters, such as the deployment and repatriation of UNMOs; requests for vehicles and equipment by verification centres; orders and directives for ONUCA operations; and the establishment and closure of verification centres and OPPs.

These records also document ONUCA's involvement in the demobilization of the Nicaraguan Resistance contain information related to the delivery of surrendered weapons; the issuance of demobilization certificates; the repatriation of refugees, as well as demobilization reports and information reports from verification centres.

S-1960 also contains a small amount of records from Observer Group Nicaragua that document ONUCA's investigations into FMLN activities within Nicaragua. These include correspondence, memoranda and reports on specific incidents.

The records of the Naval Operations Centre (NOC) Fonesca located in Honduras contain maps and colour photographs documenting the boats that were reported by UNMOs who carried out day and night patrols in the Gulf of Fonesca and off the coastal waters of Nicaragua and El Salvador. Although ONUCA patrol boats could not detain, inspect or confiscate any cargo; they verified the cessation of trans-border aid to irregular forces and insurrectionist movements and reported any suspicious activities to ONUCA headquarters. The maps note the locations suspicious vessels were seen by UNMOs and are typically accompanied by photographs. The records are arranged according to type of boat such as: military and pleasure crafts, trawlers, and kayukoes. The records also contain a sample patrol plan and contact report forms that were used to document suspicious activities.

Daily situation reports, weekly patrol schedules, patrol briefings and reports, reconnaissance reports, and monthly operational reports compiled by Observer Group Liaison Offices in Costa Rica, Honduras, El Salvador, Guatemala, and Nicaragua were received by the CMO. These records document administrative and operational developments, including: investigations; patrols; liaison activities; movement of personnel; and logistical matters such as accommodations for UNMOs, vehicles and medical situations.

The records also contain a partial set of daily situation reports sent to Marrack Goulding, Under-Secretary-General (USG) for Political Affairs at UN Headquarters in New York. These reports are a compilation of daily situation reports received from all Observer Group liaison offices and NOC Fonesca and date from February to December 1990.

S-1960 also contains one box of records of the CMO that consists of incoming and outgoing correspondence to the Chiefs of Observer Groups in Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras and Nicaragua.

S-1961 Political Affairs 1989-1992

Scope and Content

The records in S-1961 document the work of the Political Adviser and Political Affairs Officer (PAO)/Public Information Officer (PIO) of the United Nations Observer Group in Central America (ONUCA) and consist of correspondence and memoranda; reports; press releases; press clippings; code cables and cryptofaxes. The function of S-1961 is derived from PKO-POL-101 and PKO-PUC-101 of the United Nations Peacekeeping Records Retention Schedule (Field Missions), dated November 2015. The bulk of the records are from 1979 to 1992.

The records of Rolf Knutsson, the Political Adviser for ONUCA, are contained within this series. Stationed at ONUCA headquarters in Tegucigalpa, Honduras, Mr. Knutsson provided support to the Chief Military Observer (CMO) on all political aspects of ONUCA's activities and coordinated with civilian staff, including the PAO/PIO and Legal Affairs Officer. Throughout ONUCA's existence, Mr. Knutsson's position was also referred to as the Senior Political Adviser (SPA) and the Principal Political Adviser (PRA). These records contain Mr. Knutsson's chronological files; incident reports and correspondence concerning the Farabundo Martí National Liberation Front (FMLN) in El Salvador; information summaries and meeting summaries received from the Military Information Officer (MIO); and reference materials regarding the deployment of armed forces in each of the countries where ONUCA was based.

Many of these records document the demobilization of the Nicaraguan Resistance and the verification of the cessation of aid to irregular forces in Nicaragua. The records contain minutes from meetings between the leaders of the Nicaraguan Resistance and ONUCA; reports about the Nicaraguan Resistance forces; incident reports and investigations received from the Observer Group Liaison Office in Nicaragua; faxes from the Chief of Observer Group Nicaragua to the CMO; as well as memoranda and reports from the MIO. Correspondence, reports, and press clippings sent from the PAO of the Observer Group Nicaragua are also contained within this series.

S-1961 also contains records of the PAO/PIO, who headed the Public Information Office at ONUCA headquarters in Tegucigalpa, Honduras. The PAO/PIO was responsible for media and public relations and served as the spokesperson for the mission. Angelica Hunt served as the first PIO, assuming the position in March 1990 and was succeeded by Isel Rivero. The PAO/PIO coordinated with political affairs officers in ONUCA liaison offices in Guatemala, Costa Rica, Nicaragua, El Salvador and Honduras to obtain specific information from those regions. The records contain: ONUCA

press releases; press clippings from local Spanish-language newspapers; applications for press credentials; and inquiries from international organizations, embassies, journalists, and the general public. Additionally, the files contain correspondence and memoranda documenting relations with the local media; video coverage of the demobilization of the Nicaraguan Resistance and repatriation of refugees; and a documentary on ONUCA that was produced by the University for Peace.

S-1961 also includes a draft of "The ONUCA Observer," a publication produced by the mission. Each section of "The ONUCA Observer" was written by an ONUCA staff member. The draft publication includes messages from Secretary-General Javier Pérez de Cuellar, Under-Secretary-General for Special Political Affairs Marrack Goulding, and CMO Agustín Quesada Gómez, as well as an interview with Angelica Hunt discussing her time as the PAO/PIO. These records also include more than 150 corresponding photographs that document ONUCA staff members, buildings, and operations.

Scope and Content

The records in S-1962 contain administrative instructions, information circulars, correspondence, and reports created by the Office of the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) of the United Nations Observer Group in Central America (ONUCA). The function of S-1962 is derived from PKO-DMS-101 of the United Nations Peacekeeping Records Retention Schedule (Field Missions), dated November 2015. The bulk of the records are from 1989 to 1992.

The CAO served as the head of civilian staff at ONUCA headquarters in Tegucigalpa, Honduras and oversaw the civilian sections of the mission including: Communications, Finance, General Services, Personnel, Procurement, and Transport. Vittore Rottici served as the first CAO and was succeeded by Noel Francois in April 1990. The records consist of: administrative instructions and information circulars issued by the CAO; contributions to the Chief Military Observer's (CMO) monthly reports concerning the status of ONUCA's civilian administration; and correspondence and memoranda detailing logistical aspects of air and naval operations, mission financing, and administrative support provided to the United Nations Observer Mission in El Salvador (ONUSAL).

S-1962 also contains a small amount of records received from the Legal Adviser, including Status of Force Agreements (SOFAs), as well as English- and Spanish-language reference copies of the "Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the United Nations" adopted by the General Assembly on 13 February 1946.
