Subjects include but are not limited to the following: U Thant's efforts to mediate Vietnam conflict; cessation of bombing by United States; United States withdrawal from Vietnam; USSR's relationship with Vietnam; Ralph Bunche's meetings with Adlai Stevenson; possibility of United Nations observers in Saigon; U Thant's meetings with Arthur Goldberg, United States Representative to the United Nations; negotiations leading up to the Paris Peace talks; and the Pope's potential visit to Vietnam.
